At Metalon we care about our impact on the environment, both locally and globally. We take many precautions in order to reduce our environmental footprint and we pride ourselves on working in an ethical manner.

We are a local and locally owned business. The majority of our products are made on site in Dunedin, so they travel a shorter distance to reach our clients, requiring less transport. They are quality built and long lasting, which reduces the need for replacement. Metalon also encourages and offers furniture refurbishment and repairs. This is a large part of our business and is one of the biggest differences between us and our competitors.

We source board, timber and paper from sustainable forest sources and any waste is recycled or disposed of by licensed contractors.

We recommend sustainable products to our customers and offer many eco-friendly fabrics that utilise recycled plastic feedstock.

We also respect the environment through our active waste minimization and energy efficiency programme, which includes recycling our packaging as well as using reusable packaging such as blankets.

We encourage our staff to cycle to work by providing indoor bicycle parking, which is used by staff members on a regular basis.

Metalon is always thinking about ways to improve systems and processes. For example, our aim is to replace our fleet with electric vehicles by 2028.
